SWWA PRESIDENTS 2009 ANNUAL REPORT

The SWWA 27th annual conference and tradeshow held on November 3, 4 and 5 was another huge success. A total of 456 registered delegates were in attendance at T.C.U Place convention center in Saskatoon.

The second annual Operators Certification Board (OCB) stakeholder's meeting was again held at the Saskatoon Hilton Garden Inn hotel. There was representation from all facility levels. Ms. Tracey Helmink this year's OCB Chair gave an overview of the boards activities for the 2009 year. Mr. Thon Phommavong gave some insight into the Ministry's role and direction. Mr. Rod Broadfoot gave news about certification CEUs and information about the ongoing discussion with the other provinces and territories regarding "best certification practices".

This year's conference agenda included eleven technical sessions and six concurrent workshops. The sessions covered various topics regarding the water and wastewater treatment, water distribution and wastewater collection industry. "Exactly what is free chlorine?" Presented by Dr. Peter Hombach, Irene Motnenko and Jeff Dyck and "Water Distribution System Maintenance" presented by Garry Tenaschuk of ATAP, Saskatoon. These workshops continue to be a way

for delegates to increase their knowledge of the processes and products in our industry whilst receiving CEUs for their certification.

The Trade Show "Watering Hole and Ice Breaker" was well attended and continues to be provided compliments of our suppliers. This year we had 96 booths displaying a variety of products and services related to the industry.

Saskatoon's Mayor Don Atchison sent his welcome as he was unable to attend due to a prior commitment. This year's keynote speaker, Mr. Bill Hyslop from the Association of Board of Certification (ABC), gave a history of Operator Certification in Canada, where we are now, and what the future could look like. Ron Babyck from North Battleford returned for another one year term, Milton Wood from Carrot River, Craig Erhardt from Christopher Lake and Dave Merkel from Whitewood were the new directors with one year term positions

2009 SWWA Awards to SIAST Students

On November 26, 2009, the Saskatchewan Institute of Applied Science and Technology (SIAST) announced the 2009 recipients of two SWWA scholarships awarded to SIAST students. Presentation was made by Gus Feitzelmayer, SWWA Training Coordinator.

The **Saskatchewan Water and Wastewater Association Centennial Merit Scholarship** was awarded to Dayton Weisgerber of the Water Resources Engineering Technology Division. This \$1,500 scholarship is matched by Saskatchewan Advanced Education, Employment and Labour. It is awarded on a Saskatchewan High School graduate enrolled full-time in the on-campus Water Resources Engineering Technology program. It is based on the highest average of English Language



Arts (A-30 & B-30) and Social Studies 30 or Native Studies 30 and the highest grade in 20 or 30 level Math and Science.

The **Gus Feitzelmayer Scholarship** was awarded to Monica Ernst, also of the Water Resources Technology Division. This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a 5th Semester Water Resources Engineering Technology student. It is based on the highest academic standing in the 3rd and 4th Semester of Water Chemistry, Water & Wastewater Treatment and Ground Water Hydrology.
